

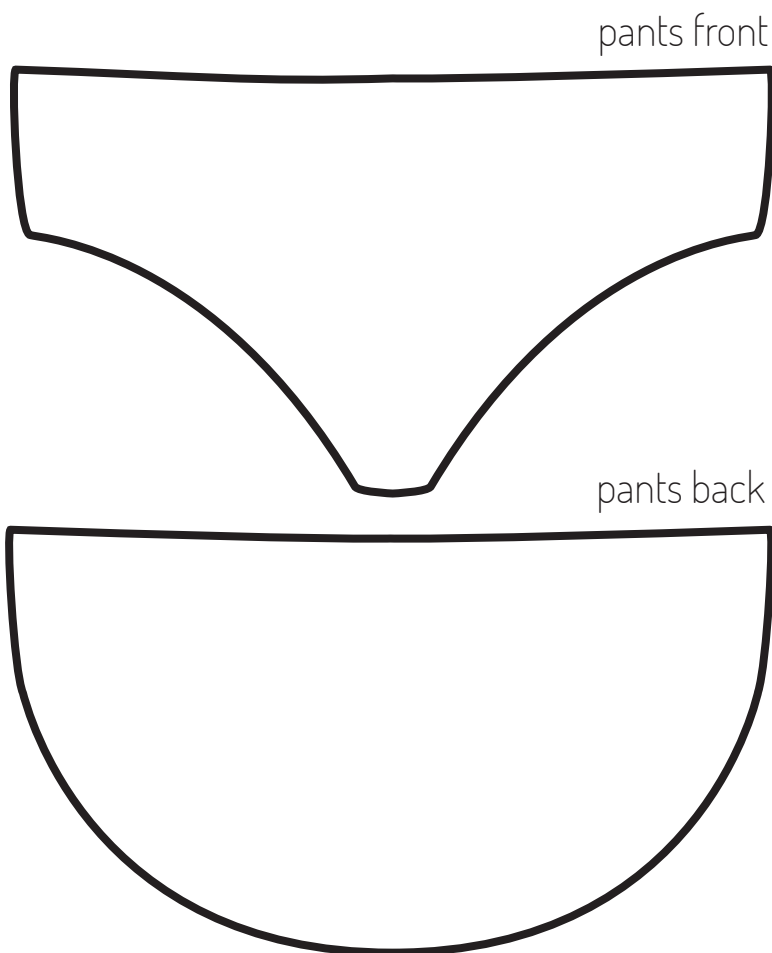
DIY craftivism printable pants instructions for Cervical Screening Awareness Week, 14th-20th June 2021
